Open Horse Show Leadline Rules and Entry Form**

The Brown County Fair Open Horse show offers a leadline class as an opportunity for youth in second grade and under to begin to gain the knowledge and skills involved in showing horses. A leadline class will be held at 12:00 noon on Friday, August 15, 2008 in the horse arena.

Rules

1. Children must have a person leading their horse, but may also have a sidewalker.
2. One class will be held: Second grade and under. Age is determined as of January 1 of the current year. A large class may be further split.
3. Horse/pony must be at the fair already.
4. Children are required to wear a helmet and hardsole, 1/2 inch heel shoes or boots.
5. Children will be judged on the way they handle their horse/pony.
