RULES

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in the Beef Project or doing similar work in another youth organization to exhibit/show.
2. To exhibit an animal at the Brown County Fair, youth must have been in third grade during the current year.
3. Each animal over 6 months old must have a permanent identification number to exhibit at the fair. **See ANIMAL HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS for further information.**
4. No one may approach the judge before or during the show. Technical questions should be directed to the ring steward, superintendent, or if they are not available, to the fair office. Exhibitors are encouraged to thank the judge for their work after the show is complete.
5. Only one entry per lot number.

AGE CLASSIFICATIONS

(2) Beef Cattle.

A junior calf is one born on or after January 1 of the exhibit year. The calf shall be at least 4 months old at the time of the exhibit.

A senior calf is one whose date of birth is between September 1 and December 31 of the year preceding the exhibit year.

A summer yearling is one whose date of birth is between May 1 and August 31 of the year preceding the exhibit year.

A junior yearling is one whose date of birth is between January 1 and April 30 of the year preceding the exhibit year.

A senior yearling is one whose date of birth is between September 1 and December 31 of the second year preceding the exhibit year.

A 2 year-old or older cow is one born before September 1 of the second year preceding the exhibit year and which has calved during the past year.
