PLEASE NOTE:

To receive premium, all sewing items and posters must be judged at the Brown County UW-Extension Office on June 23 and brought to the Brown County Fair on Tuesday, August 12, 2008. The style Revue is encouraged, but optional.

RULES

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in the Clothing project or doing similar work in another youth organization to exhibit/show.
2. Items will be accepted for exhibit, if they are clean and pressed.
3. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per lot number.
4. Articles must be made by members enrolled for the current year, and since last year's fair.
5. All posters must be 14" x 22".
6. Fleece blanket that are tied will not be accepted as a clothing project. See Home Environment.
7. All garments/articles must be sewn by exhibitor unless listed as "purchased."
8. All articles must have hand or machine stitching.

RULES

1. Open to all clothing members or other youth doing equivalent work.

 - Suitability of garment to individual
 - Purpose as to color and design
 - General appearance, neatness, posture, fit
 - Construction as it affects general appearance
3. Members can select one garment made for self and/or 1 garment made for another individual. Garment made for another individual must be modeled by that individual.
4. Must participate in Fair Fashion Revue held during the Fair in order to receive ribbon and premium.
5. Style revue judged in June.
