RULES

1. Exhibitor must be enrolled in the rabbit project or doing similar work in another youth organization to exhibit/show.
2. To exhibit an animal at the Brown County Fair, youth must have been in at least the third grade during the current year.
3. Exhibitor must be in possession of animal by June 1 of current year.
4. Only one rabbit may be entered per lot except for the meat pen lot. Exhibitor can enter no more than 4 rabbits per breed.
5. A junior doe or junior buck must be under 6 months of age and abide by the ARBA minimum weight requirements for each breed.
6. An intermediate doe or intermediate buck must be between the ages of 6-8 months.
7. A senior doe or senior buck is over 8 months of age.
8. Each exhibit must have a legible tattoo in the left ear. Tattoo may be with either permanent marker or a permanent tattoo.
9. Exhibitors must provide their own food for their animals. Exhibitors must provide they're own dishes for food and water and are responsible for watering, feeding, and cleaning cages daily. Locks may not be used on cages.
10. Exhibits with infectious diseases may not be entered.
11. Class W– Pet Rabbits will be released immediately following judging. See Superintendent.
12. No one may approach the judge before or during the show. Technical questions should be directed to the ring steward, superintendent, or if they are not available, to the fair office. Exhibitors are encouraged to thank the judge for their work after the show is complete.
