

**2008 Brown County Fair
Kiddie Dairy Showmanship Rules and Entry Form**

The Brown County Fair Kiddie Dairy Showmanship is an opportunity for youth between the ages of 4 and 8 as of January 1 of the current year to begin to gain the knowledge and skills involved in showing dairy animals. Kiddie Dairy Showmanship will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 16, 2008 in the South Show Barn.

Rules

1. Calves must be born between March 1 and July 1 of the current year. It can be a heifer, steer, or bull. Due to safety concerns, no over-age calves will be allowed.
2. Two classes will be held: 4-6 year old group and 7-8 year old group. Age is determined as of January 1 of the current year. Large classes may be further split.
3. Calves should be brought to the fair by 10:30 a.m. on Saturday.
4. Children are required to wear a showmanship number that will be distributed prior to the show.
5. Children will be judged on the way they handle their calf and basic showmanship show skills. No coaching of exhibitors during the show will be allowed.
6. Rest your calf before the show begins.
7. Families with children in both age groups may show the same calf. Families with two or more children in the same age group may not share the same animal.
8. Two trophies will be presented in each age group. Ribbons will be given to all participants.
