RULES

1. See page 50 for Open Division rules.
2. See pages 6-9 for ATCP 160 regulations.
3. See pages 10-12 for animal health requirements.
4. The Animal Stall, Pen & Cage Reservation Form must be included with the Open & Senior Division Entry Form. No entries will be considered unless both of these forms are submitted. Not more than 4 goats allowed in 1 pen.
5. All goats exhibited must be confined in pens, and not allowed to run at large on the fairgrounds during the fair.
6. Exhibitors must furnish their own trough.
7. Exhibitors showing purebred animals 1 year or over in this department will be required to show certification of registry to superintendent which certificate of registry of sire and dam will be required.
8. All registration transfers must be made at least 20 days prior to the fair.
9. Only one entry per lot number. No animal, irrespective of the number of entries in the class in which it is entered, shall be awarded a higher rating than its merit would entitle it to in comparison to the standard of perfection in the class (state regulation).
10. No animal may be entered in any other name than of its owner.
