RULES

1. See page 50 for Open Division rules.
2. See pages 6-9 for ATCP 160 regulations.
3. See pages 10-12 for animal health requirements.
4. Animal Stall, Pen & Cage Reservation information must be included with the Open & Senior Division Entry Form. Not more than 4 sheep allowed in 1 pen.
5. All sheep exhibited must be confined in pens, and not allowed to run at large on the fairgrounds during the Fair.
6. Exhibitors must furnish their own trough.
7. Exhibitors showing purebred animals 1 year or over in this department will be required to show certificate of registry to superintendent which certificate must show that animal is registered in the name of the exhibitor in registry office.
8. All registration transfers must be made at least 20 days prior to the fair.
9. Only one entry per lot number. No animal, irrespective of the number of entries in the class in which it is entered, shall be awarded a higher rating than its merit would entitle it to in comparison to the standard of perfection in the class (state regulation).
10. Registered Columbias, Corriedales, Rambouillets and Targhees shall be shown with two inches or less of wool. All other breeds shall have been completely shorn not more than 2 months nor less than 2 weeks prior to show date.
11. No animal may be entered in any other name than that of its owner.
12. Animals in all classes must be registered purebreds
