RULES

1. See page 50 for Open Division rules.
2. See pages 6-9 for ATCP 160 regulations.
3. See pages 10-12 for animal health requirements.
4. Animal Stall, Pen & Cage Reservation information must be included with the Open & Senior Division Entry Form.
5. All registration transfers must be made at least 20 days prior to the fair.
6. All swine must be confined to their pens, and not allowed to run at large on the fair grounds during the fair.
7. Exhibitors must furnish their own trough.

8. Market hog classes will be determined by the swine superintendent after weigh in. There will be 3 classes: light, intermediate, and heavy weighing 220 lbs. to 280 lbs. Exhibitor will be awarded one premium per weight class.
9. A mature boar or sow is one born during the period of August 1 of the third year preceding exhibit year to January 31 of the year preceding the exhibit year.
10. Exhibitors in the department showing animals of 6 months or over will be required to show certificate of registry to superintendent which certificate must show that animal is registered in the name of exhibitor in registry office.
11. Only one entry per lot number. No animal, irrespective of the number of entries in the class in which it is entered, shall be awarded a higher rating that its merit would entitle it to in comparison to the standard of perfection in the class (state regulation).
12. No animal may be entered in any other name than that of its owner.
13. No more hogs shall be allowed in any one pen than the following:

One only per pen:

Boar, 1 year or older
Sow, 1 year or older

Two only per pen:

Boar, 6 months and under 1 year
Sow, 6 months and under 1 year

Four only per pen:

Boar, under 6 months
Sow, under 6 months
Barrow

14. Exhibits in this department shall not be removed before 6:00 p.m. Sunday, closing day of the Fair. Anyone violating shall automatically forfeit premiums awarded.
15. Animals entered in Lot #11 cannot compete in Lot #12.
16. Animals in all classes must be registered purebreds.
17. Any exhibitor failing to properly care for any livestock exhibit at the fair will forfeit all premiums.
18. No animal sales are permitted during the fair other than at the auction.
