

**2012 Brown County Fair  
Open Horse Show Leadline Rules and Entry Form**

The Brown County Fair Open Horse show offers a leadline class as an opportunity for youth in second grade and under to begin to gain the knowledge and skills involved in showing horses. A leadline class will be held **before Equitation Class G on Friday, August 17, 2012** in the Horse Arena.

**Rules**

1. Children must have a person leading their horse. This person must be 18 years or older. They may also have a side walker.
2. One class will be held: Second grade and under (Grade as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the exhibit year). A large class may be further split.
3. Horse/pony must be at the fair already.
4. Children are required to wear a helmet and hard sole, 1/2 inch heel, shoes or boots.
5. Children will be judged on the way they handle their horse/pony.
