**CLASS A – CLOVERBUDS**

**GENERAL RULES:**

1. **Awards:** One Participant Ribbon per exhibit will be awarded to each exhibitor. No premiums will be given.
2. **Entry Limit:** Each exhibitor is limited to 4 entries.
3. **Exhibitor Requirement:** Exhibitors must be in Grades K-2 and enrolled in the Cloverbuds project or doing similar work in another youth organization in order to exhibit/show.
4. **Poster Size:** All posters are to be no larger than 14" x 22".

5. Art project (drawing, painting, etc.)
6. Ceramic or plaster-like item
7. Crochet, macramé or knit article
8. Cut flowers you have cared for, 3, in a pint jar or covered tin can
9. Decorated cupcake or cookie, 1
10. Drawings or photographs you have taken of your family with captions about what makes each one special
11. Exhibit about a place you have visited on family or group tours (scrapbook, display or poster)

3. **Poster Size:** All posters are to be no larger than 14" x 22".
