GENERAL RULES:

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in the Clothing project or doing similar work in another youth organization in order to exhibit/show.
2. Items for exhibit must be clean and pressed.
3. All posters must be 14" x 22".
4. Tied Fleece Blankets & Pillows that are tied are to be entered in "Home Environment", not Clothing.
5. All garments/articles must be sewn by exhibitor unless listed as "purchased".
6. All articles must have hand or machine stitching.

- Suitability of garment to individual
- Purpose as to color and design
- General appearance, neatness, posture, fit
- Construction as it affects general appearance

2. Members can select one garment made for self and/or 1 garment made for another individual. Garment made for another individual must be modeled by that individual.
3. Must participate in Fair Fashion Revue held during the Fair in order to receive ribbon and premium.
4. Style Revue judged in June.
