## **GENERAL RULES:**

### **Exhibitor:**

1. **Entry Requirements:**

- Exhibitors showing Purebred Animals 1 year or over will be required to show Certificate of Registry to Superintendent; Certificate must show that animal is registered in the name of the Exhibitor
- All Registration Transfers must be made at least 20 days prior to the Fair.

2. **Day of Show Questions:** Exhibitors are not allowed to approach the judge before or during the show. Technical questions should be directed to the ring steward or superintendent.

### **Animal:**

1. **Ownership:** Only Animals registered in Owner's Name may be shown.

2. **Purebred:** Animals in all classes must be registered purebreds.

3. **Shearing:**

- Registered Columbias, Corriedales, Rambouillets & Targhees shall be shown with 2 inches or less of wool.
- All other breeds shall have been completely shorn not more than 2 months or less than 2 weeks prior to Show Date.
- For safety reasons, animals cannot be sheared in the barn aisles. Please contact Carl Falish (Beef Superintendent) for alternative options. Failure to comply may result in loss of premiums and/or removal from future fair entry.

4. **Trough:** Exhibitors must furnish their own trough.

## **AGE CLASSIFICATIONS:**

\*(**Preceding Year** = January 1<sup>st</sup> – December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year **prior** to the fair)

\*(**Exhibit Year** = January 1<sup>st</sup> – December 31<sup>st</sup> of the Year **of** the Fair)

- Spring Lamb:** A spring lamb is one born on or after February 16 of the Exhibit Year.
- Fall Lamb:** A fall lamb is one born between September 1 and December 31 of the Preceding Year.
- Winter Lamb:** A winter lamb is one born between January 1 and February 15 of the Exhibit Year.
- Yearling:** A yearling ram or ewe is one born outside the date of birth limitations in paragraphs (a) through (c). The age of yearling may be subject to verification by a veterinarian's examination whose findings shall be final.
- Market Lamb:** A market lamb is one born after January 1 of the Exhibit Year.
