GENERAL RULES:

***Exhibit Year:** January 1- Fair Date of the Current Fair Year

Exhibitor:

- Entries:**
 - ↔ Exhibitor can enter no more than 4 rabbits per breed
 - ↔ Only one Rabbit may be entered per lot except for the Meat Pen Lot
- Food & Bedding:** Exhibitors must provide their own food and bedding for their animals. Exhibitors must provide their own dishes for food and water, & are responsible for watering, feeding, and cleaning cages daily.
- Ownership:** Exhibitor must be in possession of animal by June 1 of Exhibit Year.
- Show Day Questions:** Exhibitors are not allowed to approach the judge before or during the show. Technical questions should be directed to the superintendent.

Animals:

- Age/Weight Requirements:**
 - ↔ A *junior doe* or *junior buck* must be under 6 months of age and abide by the ARBA minimum weight requirements for each breed.
 - ↔ An *intermediate doe* or *intermediate buck* must be between the ages of 6-8 months.
 - ↔ A *senior doe* or *senior buck* is over 8 months of age.
- Disease:** Exhibits with infectious diseases may not be entered.
- Entries:** Only one rabbit may be entered per lot, except for the Meat Pen lot.
- Identifying Mark:** Each exhibit must have a legible tattoo in the left year. Tattoo may be with either permanent marker or permanent tattoo.
- Spay/Neuter:** Any spayed or neutered rabbits should be entered as pet rabbits.

2. A single rabbit, spayed or neutered, 6 months of age or under, not shown in any other Purebred class.

CLASS AC – MARKET:**LOT NO.**

1. Roaster (between 70-180 days old or over 5 pounds)
2. Fryer (not over 69 days old or not over 5 pounds)
3. Stewers (over 6 months and over 8 pounds)
4. Meat Pen (any 3 rabbits same breed)
