GENERAL RULES:

1. **Entry Tags:** Entry Tags must be Securely Attached to Each Item PRIOR to Checking Item in Department.
2. **History of item:** On a 3" x 5" Index Card, Describe & Give and a Brief History of Item. Staple to Entry Tag. Judge will read Entry's Card and the Card may be Used to Break a Tie.
3. **Judging:** Items will be Judged on Quality. (I.e. if Item was Cleaned, Polished, has Cracks, etc...)
4. **Repeat Items:** Items Once Exhibited Cannot Return Another Year to be Exhibited Again.
5. **Safety:** Every Precaution will be taken to Insure the Safety of Exhibits, but the Brown County Fair Association and its Volunteers will Not be held Responsible for Loss or Injury.
